The undersigned hereby grants and assigns to PGA TOUR, Inc., without limitation, the undersigned's individual television, radio, motion picture, photographic, electronic, internet "Interactive Applications" (as defined below) and all other media rights with respect to the undersigned's participation in the qualifying tournament or any portion thereof (i.e., at all times on-site during Tournament week and during any Tournament-related activities), or any other footage of the undersigned that may be captured by PGA TOUR Entertainment or its contractors with the undersigned's permission, with the understanding that PGA TOUR's use thereof shall be limited to the following: (1) advertising, promoting or publicizing the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica, PGA TOUR, PGA TOUR charitable initiatives, tournaments or any broadcasts thereof; (2) live broadcasts during tournaments, (3) broadcasts or exhibitions on a recorded basis as part of a program or motion picture of tournaments or year-end summaries of sports award programs, any news or sports news or other programs or any other transmission, reproduction, recording, or photograph of tournaments in any and all media now known or hereafter developed; provided, that no rights are being granted hereunder by the undersigned for use in any program or motion picture designed for instructional purposes; and (4) live or taped nonexclusive updates. The undersigned understands that use of social media during the Tournament is permitted to the extent provided in the PGA TOUR Trial Guidelines for Players Posting/Streaming to Social Media on Site and At Events, as may be amended by TOUR ("Social Media Guidelines") and agrees to comply with the Social Media Guidelines. The undersigned agrees to refrain from any action which will interfere with PGA TOUR's ownership of the rights hereunder granted and assigned to PGA TOUR or with any authorized use thereof. The undersigned also agrees to abide by and be governed by the PGA TOUR Tournament Regulations currently in effect (and, if a member of PGA TOUR, attest that a copy thereof has been furnished to me) and by the Rules of Golf of the R & A, subject to any modifications thereof approved by PGA TOUR.

The undersigned hereby declares that they have the financial capacity to support themselves on the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica for one full year and that the foregoing information furnished by player in the Application is true and complete; and understands that any materially false statements herein furnished by player may result in their expulsion from the Tournament and the suspension or termination of their playing privileges in tournaments cosponsored, approved or endorsed by PGA TOUR.

DRUG TESTING: I understand that drug testing may be conducted on players pursuant to the PGA TOUR Anti-Doping Program ("the Anti-Doping Program"). As a potential member of PGA TOUR Latinoamérica, I consent to and agree to be bound by all requirements of the Ant-Doping Program specifically including but not limited to my agreement: to provide a urine and/or blood sample, as specified by PGA TOUR, to any testing agency authorized by the PGA TOUR at any time or place without advance notice; that refusal to provide the type of sample required by PGA TOUR, if requested, will constitute an anti-doping rule violation; that any sample collected shall become the property of the PGA TOUR; that the PGA TOUR may disseminate information pertaining to me relevant to the Anti-Doping Program, as permitted by the Anti-Doping Program; and that the Results Management provisions of the Anti-Doping Program shall provide the sole and exclusive method for resolving any dispute related to drug testing.

**INTEGRITY**: The PGA TOUR Integrity Program is intended to maintain integrity and prevent betting-related corruption in PGA TOUR Latinoamérica competitions. I consent and agree to be bound by all terms of the PGA TOUR Integrity Program Manual (the "Integrity Program Manual") with respect to my participation in the Tournament. The Integrity Program Manual, among other things prohibits me from betting on the Tournament and providing inside information to third parties for purposes of betting on the Tournament; requires me to report any violations of the Integrity Program Manual to the PGA TOUR; and establishes a process for the monitoring, investigation, sanctioning and disclosure of violations of the Integrity Program Manual.

#### Procedures & Information:

#### **Format**

72-hole stroke play event.

Membership will be awarded to a total of 40 players and any player tied for 40<sup>th</sup> position at each site. The top finisher at each site will be exempt for the entire 2022-23 season and not subject to reshuffle\*.

Finishers placing second (2<sup>nd</sup>) through twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) at each site will receive exempt status up to the reshuffle\*. Finishers placing thirteenth (13<sup>th</sup>) to fortieth (40<sup>th</sup>), including ties, will receive conditional status and will be eligible for the reshuffle\*.

\*A reshuffle will take place after a certain number of events, as determined by PGA TOUR Latinoamérica (approximately after the first half of the season), based upon each player's position on the current PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Points List.

# Field Size

There will be a maximum of 120 players per site. All 2021-22 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica members, 2022 Korn Ferry Tour members and 2022 PGA TOUR Canada members will receive priority status with respect to their preferred site if their applications are received by October 4, 2022 at 5:00 pm Eastern Standard Time. All other applications received before October 4, 2022 at 5:00 pm Eastern Standard Time will be assigned based on a random selection of the applications. All entries received after October 4, 2022 at 5:00 pm Eastern Standard Time will be processed on a first come first served basis, subject to availability.

Should the fields reach the maximum number of players, an alternate list will be created.

If a player's preferred site is full, he will be contacted and he may choose to play another site (if space is available), be put on the alternate list or withdraw.

A player who is confirmed in one site and an alternate for another must determine his selection to play in the confirmed site or withdraw from the confirmed site and remain an alternate by Tuesday October 18th, 2022, 5:00 pm Eastern Standard USA Time. Failure to notify your selection will result in the player remaining in the confirmed site and will be taken off the alternate list.

#### **Entry Deadline**

Tuesday, October 25, 2022, 5:00pm Eastern Standard USA Time.

No entries will be accepted via telephone.

Entrants will receive site assignments and pertinent information via e-mail beginning October 5, 2022.

# **Entry Fees**

Entry fee of US\$1,750 must accompany application and is payable only by credit card. Entry fee includes: green fee, range usage on the practice and competition days and liability insurance coverage, covering liability which may arise as a result of the applicant's presence at a Qualifying Tournament site.

#### Eligibility

Professionals and Amateurs with a handicap index when applied to the qualifying course slope will generate a handicap of two (2) or less. The PGA TOUR reserves the right to verify the handicap index of amateurs and to refuse anyone not meeting the requirements.

In accordance with PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Tournament Regulations, a player **must be 18 years of age or older** to be eligible for membership. A player under the age of 18 may enter the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Qualifying Tournament, provided the player turns 18 on or before the first scheduled round of the final official money PGA TOUR Latinoamérica tournament of the following season. If a player under the age of 18 qualifies for PGA TOUR Latinoamérica, the player would not become eligible for PGA TOUR Latinoamérica membership until his 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.

In accordance with PGA TOUR University Ranking List eligibility, collegiate players who play in the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Qualifying Tournament will be removed from the Official PGA TOUR University Ranking List in the current year or in any future years.

#### **Playoffs**

If necessary, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine the winner at each site and to determine the last exempt position at each site.

# **Starting Times**

Starting times will be available two days preceding the Qualifying competition at the host facilities or on the web at pgatourla.com.

# Withdrawals & Refunds

Applicants who withdraw before Tuesday October 18, 2022 at 5:00 pm will receive a refund minus a US\$250 withdrawal fee. Applicants who withdraw after October 18, 2022 at 5:00 pm and before beginning of play will receive a refund minus a US\$500. No refunds will be issued to contestants after they have started play in the Qualifying Tournament. Contestants who withdraw during the round may be subject to disciplinary action.

# **Practice Rounds**

Practice rounds must be arranged with host facilities. Practice round fees are at the discretion of the host facilities. There will be one complimentary Practice Round day before the Qualifying Tournament.

# **Rules of Golf**

Play shall be governed in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association/Rules of Golf of the R&A, as modified by the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Local Rules and Terms of the Competition and supplemented by the Notice to Players.

Pace of Play will be in accordance with 2022-23 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Pace of Play Policy except fine structure will not apply

The condition of competition for Groove Specifications in Elite Competitions will be in effect for the Qualifying Tournament.

Distance Measuring Devices are permitted during competitive qualifying rounds. Slope function MUST be turned off

# **Spike Policy**

The use of traditional metal spikes is permitted during the Competition. Soft spikes may be required during practice rounds at the discretion of the host facilities.

#### **Transportation**

Players and Caddies shall walk at all times during the Qualifying Tournament, except when permitted to ride by the Rules Committee. Players are not required to have a caddie; they may carry their clubs or use a manual or motorized pull cart.

Anyone seeking a golf cart due to a disability defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) or other applicable law should contact the PGA TOUR Competition Department at (904) 285-3700 to obtain information on procedures for

submitting such requests. All such requests due to temporary injuries or impairments that do not qualify as a "disability" under the ADA or other applicable law will not be granted.

#### **Appearance**

Players: While on the host facility property, players shall present a neat appearance in both clothing and personal grooming. Golf shorts are permitted during the practice rounds only. Blue jeans, shorts, cutoffs, T-shirts or shirts with no collar shall not be worn.

Caddies: While on the host facility property, caddies may wear either long pants or tailored solid colored knee length shorts. Blue jeans, cutoffs, T-shirts or shirts with no collar shall not be worn. Smooth rubber sole shoes are required. Sandals, open toe shoes, and golf shoes with traditional metal or soft spikes are prohibited.

#### Conduct

While on host facility property during qualifying rounds; players and caddies shall conduct themselves in a professional manner. PGA TOUR reserves the right to remove a player from the qualifying competition for; non-competitiveness; conduct unbecoming a professional by the player; conduct unbecoming a professional by the player; conduct unbecoming a professional by the player.

#### **Non-Competitive Performance**

PGA TOUR Latinoamérica reserves the right to remove an applicant from the competition if an applicant returns a non-competitive score after any round of the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Qualifying Tournament. Refunds will not be granted for any player removed from the competition for returning a non-competitive score.

#### **Reduction or Cancellation**

Any reduction or cancellation in the respective qualifying competition shall be in accordance with Reduction/Cancellation Guidelines as found in the PGA TOUR Tournament Regulations. In the event that the competition is canceled, all entry fees will be refunded.

If in the judgment of the on-site PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Rules Official or designee, whose decision shall be final, conditions render commencement or continuation of tournament play inadvisable, play shall be postponed until such time as the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Rules Official or designee determines that such weather conditions or other occurrences or conditions have improved sufficiently for play to commence or resume.

In situations involving adverse weather conditions or any other occurrence or condition, our first priority is the completion of the qualifying competition. Every effort will be made to achieve this objective by the end of the scheduled competition day.

In the event the qualifying competition cannot be completed by the end of the scheduled competitive day, play will be extended. Every effort will be made to complete the qualifying competition as soon as possible. The competitions will not continue beyond the end of the day immediately following the last scheduled tournament round of the competitions. The Bad Weather policy will be posted on site.

PGA TOUR reserves the right to change the format, venue(s), field size, qualifying spots and other criteria as presently contemplated.

# **Membership**

PGA TOUR Latinoamérica, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to elect not to award membership based on other factors

**NOTE:** Players finishing in the lowest 40 and players tied for 40th place (and below) at each site who are amateurs, players that do not become members and players under the age of 18 are included in the lowest 40 and ties.

Exempt status membership for the 2022-23 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica season will be awarded to the winner of each site.

Exempt status membership for the 2022-23 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica season up to the reshuffle will be awarded to the finishers placing second (2<sup>nd</sup>) through twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) from each site.

Conditional membership for the 2022-23 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica season will be awarded to the finishers placing thirteenth (13<sup>th</sup>) through fortieth (40<sup>th</sup>), including ties, at each site. Priority is based on finish position at each site in alternating order beginning with the first conditional finisher from Mexico, the first conditional finisher from Mission Inn, the first conditional finisher from Argentina and the first conditional finisher in Ocala. Finishers placing eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) through fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>), from the Dev Series Finals 2022 will alternate positions after the 8<sup>th</sup> place conditional finisher in Ocala. Ties will be broken at each site for the purpose of ranking on the 2022-23 eligibility list by matching final round scores. Ties remaining after the match of final round scores will be broken by matching individual hole scores in descending order, beginning with the 18th hole of the final round.

Access to PGA TOUR Latinoamérica tournaments is determined by a player's finish position at the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Qualifying Tournament and is subject to change as a result of a reshuffle that will take place after a

certain number of events, as determined by PGA TOUR (approximately after the first half of the season), based upon each player's position on the current PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Points List. The reshuffle will include exempt finishers from the qualifying tournaments, conditional finishers from the qualifying tournaments, the top 5 finishers from the 2020-21 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Points List, finishers 6 – 20 and ties from the Developmental Finals 2022, the top 3 non-members provided they are in the Top 60 on the 2022-23 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Points List up to the first reshuffle, 3rd year past champions and Korn Ferry Tour members in the top 60 that are not otherwise exempt.

The deadline to submit an Application for Membership and payment of US\$750 for annual dues and liability insurance is November 28th, 2022.

#### Key Performance Benefits for the 2022-23 PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Season:

- Any PGA TOUR Latinoamérica member who wins three (3) events during the 2022-23 PGA TOUR
   Latinoamérica season earns automatic Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2023 season and is fully exempt
   on the Korn Ferry Tour the following season.
- The Points Leader from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List earns fully exempt status (not subject to reshuffle) on the Korn Ferry Tour for the following season.
- The Points Leader from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List earns access to the Final Stage of the 2023 Qualifying Tournament for a chance to compete for a PGA TOUR card (applicable fees would be reimbursed).
- The Points Leader from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List earns a \$20,000 USD bonus from the \$100,000 USD pool.
- Finishers 2-3 from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List are elevated to the first conditional category on the Korn Ferry Tour for the following season (subject to first reshuffle).
- Finishers 4-5 from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Points List will be placed first in the zippered category that includes 76-100 Prior Season's Korn Ferry Tour Points List Finishers and Additional Finishers from the Korn Ferry Tour Qualifying Tournament (subject to first reshuffle).
- Finishers 1 through 3 from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List will be health subsidy eligible for the following season.
- Finishers 1 through 5 from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List will be exempt via a special eligibility category into the Korn Ferry Tour events played in Latin America the following season, including Panama and Colombia.
- Finishers 2 through 10 from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List will be exempt into Second Stage of the Qualifying Tournament for a chance to advance to Final Stage and compete for a PGA TOUR card (applicable fees for 2-5 would be reimbursed and finishers 6-10 will receive a discount).
- Finishers 2 through 10 from PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List will earn a bonus from the \$100.000 USD pool.
- Finishers 1 through 60 from the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Totalplay Cup Points List will be exempt on PGA TOUR Latinoamérica for the 2024 season.
- PGA TOUR Latinoamérica is recognized as part of the Official World Golf Ranking.
